Character Traits = What are the character traits that your expectations are promoting?

Expectations = What Mom and Dad specifically expect of their child. *Be specific within reason as it corresponds to age.*

Blessings = Ways that God, Mom, and Dad will bless your honorable and obedient behavior (Eph. 6:1-3).

Consequences = Both natural and intentional ways that God, Mom, and Dad will let you experience the consequences of your actions. These consequences are intended to restore you to a place of honoring and obeying.
